
POSITIONING?

We don't want to miss any opportunity to help our students improve.


HOW? Position yourself in such a way that you can see the whole mat. This means you are going to be towards the outside the class most of the time. You will not be standing beside Sensei.



YOUR GOAL is to be the "invisible mindreading superhero" who pops up out of nowhere to help wherever needed.

OBSERVE: Continually observe the entire mat, always scanning the ENTIRE class, always on the

lookout.



- Look out for students who are lost or need refocusing.
- Look out for students who need encouraging.



AVOID: Placing yourself between a student and the teacher.

AVOID: Distracting students from focussing on the teacher.

AVOID: Standing in the middle of the class.

AVOID: Being stuck on one spot for too long.
